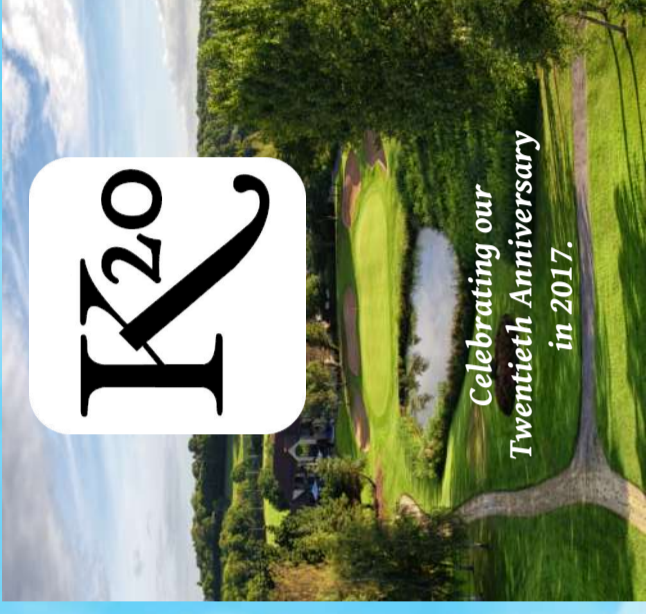

- The Kendleshire: Local Rules.**
- 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1).**
Beyond any fence, hedge or line of white stakes defining the boundary of the course, including the wire fence to the left of the 18th hole, the fence bounding the clubhouse patio, and the garden area.
Notes: wires out of bounds is defined by a fence or line of white stakes, the line joining the fence to the clubhouse patio and the line joining the fence to the garden area (excluding angled supports) defines the boundary. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies beyond such a line.
 - 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26).**
Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes or yellow lines.
Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes or red lines.
Notes:
i) Stakes defining the margin of a water hazard are movable obstructions and can be removed without penalty.
ii) Retaining artificial walls and sleepers in, surrounding or bordering water hazards and immovable obstructions. Relief without penalty is not available for a ball in the water hazard.
 - 3. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25-1).**
a) Any area enclosed by a white or blue line.
b) Any area marked with a white flag on the 18th green, in front of the 9th tee and behind the 4th tee are to be treated as GUR, from which play is prohibited.
 - 4. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24).** Includes:
a) All artificially surfaced roads and paths on the course. All other paths and tracks are integral parts of the course.
b) All drainage ditches or channels.
c) Sleepers within bunkers and elsewhere on the course, except water hazards (see local rule 2).
 - 5. Trees.**
Trees which are staked or otherwise identified or protected (eg. by wrapping). If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted (without penalty) and dropped in accordance with the procedure described in Rule 24-2b (immovable obstruction).
 - 6. Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green.**
Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball lies on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player must take relief as follows:
The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
 - 7. Stones in Bunkers.**
These are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).
 - 8. Distance Measuring Devices (Rule 14-3)**
A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.
**Additional temporary local rules will be posted on the noticeboard outside the Pro Shop.*

Safety on the Course.
Greenstaff have priority on the golf course and they will give way whenever practicable. The ball must not be played when they are in range; please wait until the way is cleared or you are called through.
Members of the public have the right of way on certain footpaths. Balls must not be played when they are in range. Please wait until the way is clear.
