

COMPETITION FORMAT:

This is a 36-hole, 4 ball better ball medal.

All players use the black card; men use black tees, ladies use green tees.

All competitors should supply WHS/CDH numbers upon entry.

85% handicap allowance (for nett event).

Max. Course Handicaps: men 18, ladies 24.

Tour-status Professionals: +4. Full-time Pro Players: +2. Club Pros: Scratch

In the event of a tie for the main trophy there will be a sudden death play-off on the 18th hole (repeating).

The tournament director's decision on any dispute is final.

TEE TIMES:

All entrants play Round 1 on Saturday 29th July and Round 2 on Sunday 30th July 2023. Both rounds will involve a morning and an afternoon two-tee-start.

The morning start will be from 8am-10am and the afternoon start will be from 12:48-2:48pm. Tee times for Round 1 will be allocated via a draw.

It is not possible to make grouping requests.

If you have a preference for morning or afternoon start please indicate on your entry form. You will be notified of your tee time via email once the draw has been made.

Tee times for Round 2 will be allocated in reverse gross score order. The gross and nett leaders after Round 1 will play at the end of the field. You will be notified of your tee time via email on the Saturday evening once the draw has been made.
